EduGrow 2015's Six Award Topics - Choose to enter one or more!

<p>1. Healthy Soil for Healthy Food and People. Show and tell us what you learnt about and did to care for healthy, productive soil in the UN Year of Soils.</p>
<p>2. Seasonal Growing Calendars for where you live! What special 'season' is it in Term 4 where you are? Create a seasonal calendar of what to grow this term that your school and community can use next year. You may like to link it with a local bush foods calendar!</p>
<p>3. Planning and Making Special Places. Show and tell us what you've done to plan, design or create a new garden or to design and create special 'places' in your school garden.</p>
<p>4. Special Visitors and Teamwork. Show and tell us about school and community teamwork and partnerships at your school that helped to plan, build and grow your garden and/or features in it.</p>
<p>5. Healthy Food and People. Create and illustrate healthy recipes from your school and community that use garden produce and/or that are special to your community and culture. Tell us why they are healthy and special!</p>
<p>6. Enterprise Projects and Activities. Develop an enterprise plan or show and tell us about an enterprise project or activity at your school that used produce from your garden or helped make healthy food more available.</p>

What your entry to each of the six award topics you wish to enter needs to include

Complete one entry form for each award topic you would like to enter. The EduGrow Entry Form is included in the Information Pack. There are three things that all entries must include to be eligible for the awards:-

1. In the Entry Form tell us in *no more than 300 words* about what you (your students, school, yourself!) did during the year and in term 4 to address the 'topic'. Tell your story creatively - imagine you are telling the story to other students to explain your achievement to them and to encourage them to try to do something similar!
2. Attach *one to three* photographs that capture the spirit and overall achievement of your entry.
3. At least *one* of the above photographs you attach must have full *talent release permissions* from all people who appear in it so that EduGrow may use the image i) to promote the awards and ii) in web-based and other resources we develop to share with other schools and students.
4. *Plus*, if you are submitting an entry to topics *2, 3 or 5* you also need to attach *additional attachments* as indicated in the table below. Be creative. Have fun. Choose the type of attachment that works best for your school, students and community partners.

Award topic	Extra attachments for this topic
1. Healthy Soil for Healthy Food and People.	<i>Optional</i> - but you may like to include a diagram or drawing that explains the science and sustainability of what you did to build healthy soil!
2. Seasonal Growing Calendars for where you live!	<i>Please include</i> one piece of simple artwork - such as a drawing, poster or other item - that shows the 'seasonal' calendar of what to grow and do in the season you experience in Term 4
3. Planning and Making Special Places.	<i>Please include</i> a simple garden plan - a drawing, map or artwork of your garden design (if that is what your entry focuses) on OR attach a photograph of special artwork or features you made for your garden if that is what you did!
4. Special Visitors and Teamwork.	<i>Optional</i> - but we'd love to hear from your special visitors and community team members about what they did with you at school! Ask them what they might like to offer and include here?!
5. Healthy Food and People.	<i>Please include</i> one illustrated recipe that shows us why the recipe is healthy and special! You can present the recipe in any way you choose!
6. Enterprise Projects and Activities.	<i>Optional</i> - but we'd love to see images or facts and figures about the healthy food products or activities that you produced or worked on!

School garden blogs, films and YouTubes. Over the years schools have submitted great blog and film links. If you have links that you can email to us – please do! We love seeing and sharing them (with your OK!) with other EduGrowers but this year we won't include them as part of the formal judging this year as time is short.

Who can enter the EduGrow 2015 Awards

The EduGrow Recognition Awards build upon the EduGrow School Garden Awards that have run in Arnhem Land since 2012. Over the years a number of schools in other remote and regional areas have asked if they can be involved. So this year the Awards are again open to all schools in Arnhem Land as well as schools from across remote, rural and regional Australia who we warmly invite and encourage to participate.

Eligible Entrants to enter the EduGrow School and Community Gardens Recognition Awards 2015 are educators, students and community groups who are located in remote, rural and regional areas across Australia. Entries may be submitted by:-

- Your school, your class and by individual students with their teacher's approval. (No more than five individual student entries per class per award topic).
- Community groups who have worked in conjunction with their school
- * Your school may submit a number of entries to each of the six award topics
- * Individuals and schools are welcome to nominate one or more (no more than three) special people for the Local Leaders and Legends Recognition Award.

Entries may be submitted by schools small and large and with students of different ages. The judging criteria and process will ensure recognition of everyone's achievements and the judges will undertake their very best endeavours to take due consideration of student ages, school size, remoteness, experience and resources.

Many community groups help build gardens and outdoor features at their school – especially after cyclones and other dramatic events! So this year community groups who have undertaken projects in conjunction with their school, are invited to enter the Recognition Awards. See the Entry Form for details.

Schools that are located in large metropolitan areas and capital cities **are not** eligible to enter the awards.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The 'Promoter' and Manager of this Competition (*EduGrow School and Community Garden Recognition Awards 2015 – 'the EduGrow 2015 awards' and 'the awards'*) is Foodswell Limited ABN 16 163 396 736, 5A Duke Place, Balmain, NSW, 2041.

4. The Competition is open to all Eligible Entrants. Eligible Entrants are educators and students of all early childhood and school ages, and community groups (who work in conjunction with their school) who are located in remote, rural and regional areas of Australia.

5. Employees of the Promoter and any person associated with the Competition, and any organisation or individual associated with the provision of prize(s), are not eligible to enter.
6. The Competition opens on October 19 2015 and closes at 5:00pm CST on Wednesday 25 November 2015 (**Competition Period**). All entrants confirm that they agree to the EduGrow How to Enter Guidelines and Terms and Conditions herein. Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition Period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries.
7. Entry into the Competition is free. Eligible and successful entry to the Competition requires the submission of one Entry Form (with required attachments as set out above in How to Enter) per award topic that entrants wish to enter and/or one or more fully completed nomination forms for the Local Leaders and Legends Recognition Award.
8. There will be one overall winning school in each of the six award topics. The overall winner of each of the six award topics will receive \$250.00 in prize money. In-kind prizes will be awarded to second and third place in each of the six award topics. The promoter reserves the right to award additional cash and in-kind prizes subject to the number and calibre of entries received to enter each of the six award topics. The Promoter reserves the right not to award cash and/or in-kind prizes in any one or more of the six award topics subject to participation levels and the quality of entries submitted.
9. The overall prize winner, and second and third place, in each of the six award topics will be awarded respectively to the entries that receive the greatest number of points according to the judges and the judging criteria that will be awarded for overall:-
 - Effort and achievement
 - Creativity
 - Sustainability – for the environment and your school and community
 - Innovative use of local knowledge and resources
 - Student engagement and participation - kids teaching kids
10. No cash or other prizes will be awarded in the Local Leaders and Legends Recognition Award.
11. The Promoter's Panel of Judges will judge the winning entrants judged using the judging criteria listed in (9) and with due consideration of different school sizes, resources and remoteness and participating student ages. The awarding of prizes is at the Judges discretion and their decisions are final. No correspondence will be entered into.
12. Chance plays no part in determining the prize winners.
13. To successfully be eligible to enter the Competition you must:
 - (i) Submit one Entry Form with required attachments by 5pm, on Wednesday 25 November 2015, for each of the award topics that you wish to enter.
 - (ii) Submit one and no more than three nomination forms per school for the Local Leaders and Legends Recognition Awards by 5pm, on Wednesday 25 November 2015.
 - (iii) Submit all Entry forms, with required attachments, and Nomination Forms by email to edugrowoffice@gmail.com
14. Each entry must be entered in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and *prefacing* How To Enter Guidelines herein. 16. An entrant is an educator, student or community group who has fully completed and submitted an entry in accordance with the hoe To Enter Guidelines and Terms and Conditions herein.
17. It is the responsibility of each participating entrant to be aware of and to obtain all permissions and consents, such as the Media and Talent Release Forms, Ochre Card approvals, and any other approvals/permissions that may apply to their student/ school activities in association with the Competition, related garden activities and student participation in them.
18. Participating schools are responsible for ensuring that all students who participate in garden activities have the appropriate attire, equipment and supervision for health and safety. All participants do so at their own risk and the Promoter accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, injury or other complaint or loss associated with the participation in this program.
19. EduGrow volunteers, Ambassadors or other contributors to EduGrow workshops and other associated events in participating communities attend, contribute and participate at their own risk.
20. Each school and entrant that submits a fully completed and valid competition entry will be eligible to receive cash and/or other prizes and commendations.
21. To be eligible for a prize, Entries must only include original work created by your school and student members, including (where applicable) any words, art, photographs, sound recordings or music.
22. All entries become the property of the Promoter and will not be returned to the entrants.
23. By submitting your school, student and/or community group Entry/s, you grant the Promoter the right to reproduce and publish all written materials, music, recordings, website and blog links, images and other materials submitted in association with your entry to the Competition on the EduGrow, RIG Network and Foodswell websites, and in respective publications such as newsletters, EduGrow storybook and other resources, including EduGrow promotional and fundraising materials.

 - (iii) your work, the content of the Entry and any Attachments are original
 - (iv) your work does not contain any commercial or recorded music
 - (v) you are the copyright owner or authorised licensor of all copyright works and subject matter comprising your work
 - (vi) the exercise of the rights granted to the Promoter in these Terms and Conditions will not infringe the rights of any third parties.

And indemnifies the Promoter against any loss or damage resulting from any breach of these warranties.
